7 June: Sheikh Abd Al-Rahman—AMZ spiritual advisor (Baqouba)

8-9 June: AMZ follow-on operations kill five additional terrorists and detain

multiple others (Baghdad)

11 June: Nazir, Aysar, Abu Thawban—foreign fighter facilitators (Al Ameriyah)

16 June: Abu Abdullah—foreign fighter tied to Sheikh Mansur (NW of Baghdad)

16 June: Sheikh Mansur and two other terrorists (Yusifiyah)

Suicide Vehicle-Borne Attack on 1/6-2 National Police June 17, 2006

Summary

- 1/6-2 Iraqi National Police inspected westbound vehicles for VBIEDs on a main E. Baghdad
- NP were suspicious of a Black Daewoo Prince approaching from passing lane. Last resort, driver detonated the device as inspection started
- Five NP soldiers injured and evacuated to Al Adnan Hospital
- Three NP soldiers treated and released, other two held in stable condition
- Hospital staffed cheered heroism of their NP
- 6/2 NP CF Special Police Transition
 Team later arrived on scene to provide first aid to some of the NP soldiers with minor wounds from the blast.
- Investigation ongoing.


Assessment

In an ongoing effort to prevent anti-Iraqi forces freedom of movement, the NP, IP, and LNs continue to be a threat and targets of AIF.



- 18 JUN 0600-19 JUN 0600: 4 Beladiyahs experienced zero daily average attacks since mid-March to mid-June



Operations Summary 16 – 19 June 2006

- 220 Coalition and Iraqi Security Forces company level and above offensive operations
 - 123 / 56% were combined Coalition Forces and Iraqi Security Forces operations
 - 80 / 36% were Iraqi Security Forces independent operations
 - 17 / 8% were Coalition Forces only operations
- These operations included
 - 15 cordon and searches
 - 6 patrols
 - 14 raids
 - 10 small unit actions
 - Sniper operations
- •These operations resulted in:
 - 12 weapons caches found and cleared
 - •163 Anti Iraqi Forces detained
 - 18 Anti Iraqi Forces killed
