National Environmental Policy Act Requirements

- Applies to Federal agencies
- EIS for major Federal actions with potential for significant impacts on the environment
- Environmental Assessment to determine if an EIS should be prepared
- After completion of EA:
 - Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI), or
 - Notice of Intent to prepare an EIS
- EIS determination
 - Notice of Intent to prepare EIS published in Federal Register on November 16, 2004

Purpose of this Scoping Meeting

- Inform the public, Federal, State, and local agencies, Tribes, and other interested parties of the proposed action
- Provide opportunity for public involvement in the Federal decision making process
- Solicit comments on the proposed action and scope of the EIS

Alternatives

"No Action Alternative"

- Continue RPS program as currently configured
 - Neptunium-237 storage at the Idaho Site
 - Target fabrication at Oak Ridge National Laboratory
 - Target irradiation in Advanced Test Reactor at the Idaho Site
 - Target processing for plutonium-238 at Oak Ridge National Laboratory
 - Plutonium-238 purification and encapsulation at Los Alamos National Laboratory
 - RPS assembly at the Idaho Site
- Consolidate nuclear operations related to RPS production at the Idaho Site -- the preferred alternative
- Other Reasonable Alternative(s) identified during the scoping period
